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Foreword

The Kinderhut Foundation is an International NGO registered in Indonesia. Its primary interest lies in the long-term systematic care of disaster victims, including orphan children and destitute women. It does so by integrating them back into a secure family environment in dedicated premises, and providing for their requisite individual needs including quality education, vocational training and domestic support.

The foundation set up the first Kinderhut Village for orphan children and destitute women in Banda Aceh, Indonesia, one of the worst hit Tsunami areas in the world. The institution today is home to 110 children and 11 women, fulfilling their every requisite need; from education and vocational training, through rehabilitation, to reintegration into family structures. Our vision is to provide a home, as opposed to an orphanage, to the children, returning to them the confidence and feelings of security they lost in tragedy.

The Kinderhut Foundation is managed and supported by a team of leading professionals and entrepreneurs of diverse nationalities, based both in the United Arab Emirates and in the organization's respective project sites across Asia. The organization is non-sectarian in character and works for the rehabilitation of children in the spirit of the U.N. Convention on the Rights of the Child. Kinderhut International has a branch office in Dubai, and is a member of the International Humanitarian City, the world's largest logistic center for humanitarian assistance activities.

Kinderhut children seems to be very happy and enthusiastically participated all the activities. It could create an emotional bonding with them.







Dr. Dawud Shah, the former director of crescent school, Chennai, India and **Mr. S.A. Mohammed Mansoor** and family visited the Kinderhut in the evening on Thursday, 5th June 2014 accompanied by **Mr. N.M.K. Farooq Maricar**, Founder trustee. They had an opportunity to go around the campus, the houses, the office, the library, the mosque etc. interacted with the students with the help of Mr. Farooq, prayed with them in the mosque and finally witnessed a fantastic cultural programme by the students.





The team again visited the Kinderhut on Saturday, 7th June 2014 in the evening and had a detailed discussion with the staff about the way the Kinderhut being organized and run with the help of the benevolent trustees from different parts. They are quite impressed about Kinderhut and have given valuable suggestions to improve and agreed to conduct partnership programme in future course of activities.

Mr. Muhammed Waseem, a volunteer from Dubai, visited KHe has given training for Boarding school children on setting their goals and to write their vision board. He could help them to express their dreams and to improvise it and ways to achieve it. The session was very interactive and activity oriented. He picked the 3 talented children among the group and suggested to give them more exposure in which the areas they have chosen



Various group games were conducted for smaller kids such as Treasure Hunt games, Back Race, Blind fold games, Question Answer games etc. He has distributed the toys and candies for the winners. Throughout his session he has given message to the children that “the importance of working hard to get the result”. After each game or activity he tried to give the message and morale of the exercise. Therefore all activities seems to be ‘learn by doing’ and were very effective.

Ms. Huichun, the wife of Mr. Muhammed Waseem, conducted a session with the care takers of Kinderhut. She analyzed the way of bringing up of our children and difficulties of taking care of them. Then she has given some suggestions such as implementing point system among children, treating with motivational talks, progress assessment of children etc.



CHAPTER 5

Visit of Volunteers

He interacted with children and shared the knowledge and motivated them for higher studies abroad.
